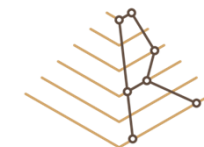

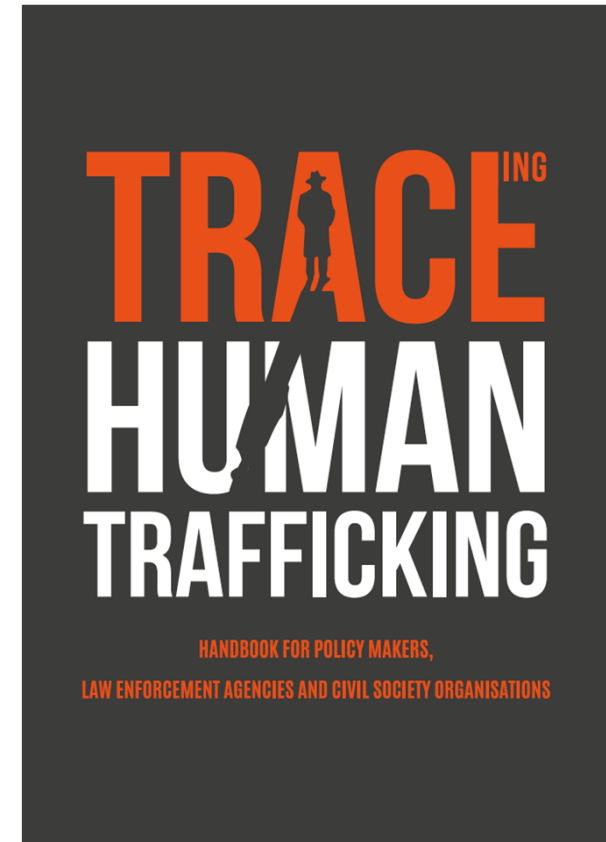

Trafficking as a Criminal Enterprise – An intelligence mapping platform (TRACE+)

- **TRACE (2014-2016) – Coordinator: Trilateral Research Ltd.**
 - Multi-disciplinary approach: legal, criminological, socio-economical, psychological, and law enforcement-oriented, to provide a full account of the phenomenon. It focused on the activities of the perpetrators by developing an understanding of the structure, social relationships, modus operandi, travel routes and technologies associated with different types of human trafficking.
 - *Significant gap in the use and availability of technologies to support LEAs.*
 - *Flagship status for the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region*
- **OBJECTIVE:** *To develop an intelligence platform for LEA's to support them in their efforts to disrupt the trafficking of human beings*
- **EXPECTED RESULTS:** *Integrated system, piloted in 6 locations, policy and operational guidance. Fully developed and implemented exploitation plan, supported by extensive stakeholder engagement, communication and dissemination activities.*

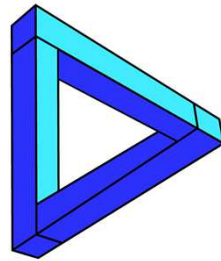
Partner Requirements:
